- You register any one or all of your existing grocery loyalty, debit and credit cards for use in the program.
- Participating merchants will make contributions to Rebuilding Together Philadelphia when you making purchases at participating retailers with the cards you have registered.
- You can earn even more by connecting to a long list of online merchants through eScrip's website.

Visit www.rewardsnetwork.com to find local restaurants that are part of the eScrip program. Purchase your meal with a registered credit card, and 2.5% of your bill will go to RTP.

How to Register

Visit www.escrip.com. Click on "Sign Up" and follow the instructions, using the Group ID provided above. Register a credit or debit card so that a percentage of your purchases at all participating merchants will be contributed to RTP. When you use this card at participating merchants, a contribution will be made to RTP automatically.
